
THE NEW ZEALAND MINING BOARD OF EXAMINERS:

CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE STATUTORY DECLARATION FOR ALL LOGBOOKS/EMPLOYMENT HISTORY PRIOR TO 1 JANUARY 2014

WorkSafe New Zealand requires all applicants to supply a certified copy of a verified logbook that shows an applicant has been employed for the required period of time or had the specified work experience. All logbooks and/or employment records submitted are required to be certified by supervisors and/or employers.

It is recommended that applicants use the WorkSafe logbook, which sets out information required by the New Zealand Mining Board of Examiners (the Board): www.business.govt.nz/worksafe/information-guidance/guidance-by-industry/extractives/documents/log-book-certificate-of-competence.pdf

If an applicant is unable to provide evidence certified by an employer and/or supervisor of work or employment experience gained prior to 1 January 2014, the applicant must supply a Statutory Declaration with the non-certified work or employment experience.
