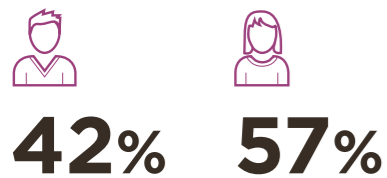


# A closer look at health and safety representatives in New Zealand

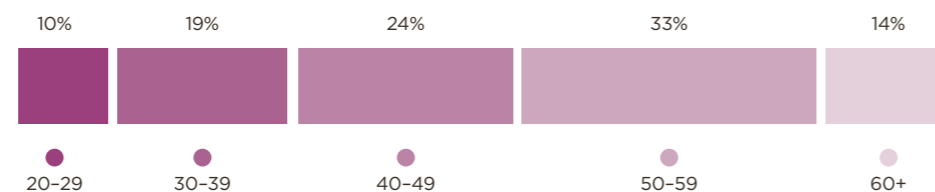

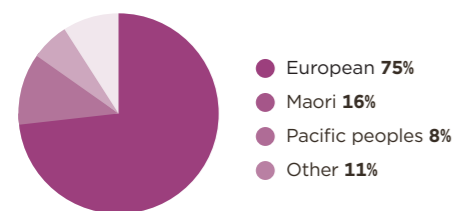

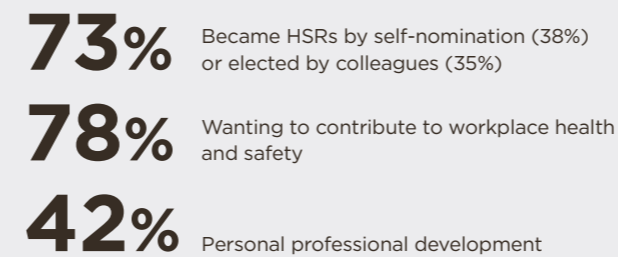

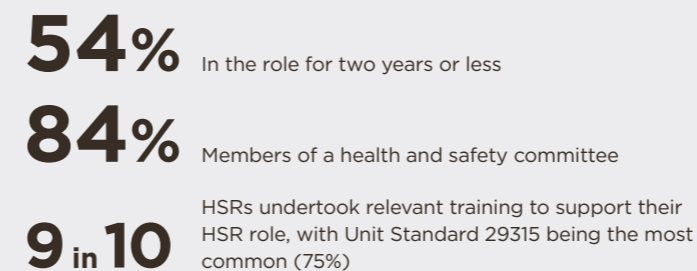

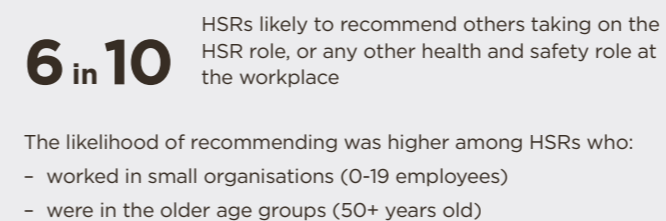


Motivations are influenced by age and length of time in the HSR role

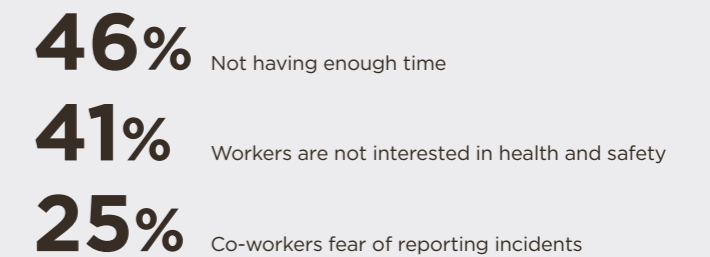

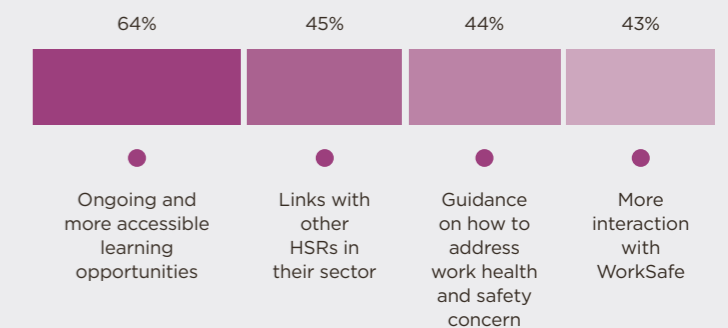
