

Exemption from provisions of Health and Safety at Work (Mining Operations and Quarrying Operations) Regulations 2016


In accordance with section 220 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 (the Act), I, Nicole Rosie, Chief Executive of WorkSafe New Zealand, exempt **Lance Rowan Bernsdorf Solly** from compliance with regulation 38(a) of the Health and Safety at Work (Mining Operations and Quarrying Operations) Regulations 2016.

I do so –

- being satisfied that:
 - the extent of the exemption is not broader than is reasonably necessary to address the matters that gave rise to it; and
 - the exemption is not inconsistent with the purpose of the Act; and
- subject to the following conditions:
 - Mr Solly must meet the qualification and experience requirements in the Gazette notice that would apply to a person who held a certificate of competence as an A-grade quarry manager under the Health and Safety in Employment (Mining Administration) Regulations 1996.
 - Mr Solly must apply for an A-grade quarry manager's certificate of competence within six months from the date this exemption takes effect.

This exemption takes effect on **17 November 2017** and expires on **17 November 2022** unless it is sooner replaced or revoked
