


EPA and WorkSafe's roles and responsibilities



WorkSafe sets specific workplace use controls:

for substances that affect human health and safety under HSWA

For 1080 set in HSW (HS) regs:

- Controlled Substance Licence (CSL), Reg 13.12, 13.13
- certified handler requirement, Reg 13.9
- additional recording and notification requirements for 1080, Reg 13.5
- importation of Sodium Fluoroacetate (1080), Reg 13.6
- requirements for aircraft carry out aerial application, Reg 13.20
- restricted access to vicinity where 1080 applied, Reg 13.21
- signage, Reg 13.19
- additional requirements for emergency management, Reg 13.45
- Workplace Exposure Standards (WES), 1080, bio 0.05 mg/m³ airborne exposure standard.

Enforcement of:

- substances being introduced into the market:
 - EPA under HSNO
- all specific workplace use controls:
 - WorkSafe New Zealand under HSWA, and ecotoxic and disposal controls in workplaces under HSNO
- substances outside the workplace:
 - Territorial Authorities: for all other public places, private dwellings or under Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA)
- breaches of permissions
 - Public Health and DOC.
