

Exemption from provisions of Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017

In accordance with section 220 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 (the Act), I, Tony Hetherington, Head of High Hazards, Energy and Public Safety of WorkSafe New Zealand, exempt **Mr Andrew Gaffney** from compliance with regulations 15.13, 15.16 and 15.17 of the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017 in respect to the Faber cylinder with serial number 03/0709/009.

I do so –

- being satisfied that:
 - the extent of the exemption is not broader than is reasonably necessary to address the matters that gave rise to it; and
 - the exemption is not inconsistent with the purpose of the Act; and
 - the cylinder has been matched to an existing cylinder design already approved by WorkSafe New Zealand; and
- subject to the following conditions:
 1. This exemption is limited to the Faber cylinder with serial number 03/0709/009.
 2. Mr Gaffney must ensure the following are stamped on the Faber cylinder with serial number 03/0709/009:
 - a. the approval number LAB7716SP in accordance with regulation 15.60
 - b. the station mark of Ocean's Alive New Zealand Limited in accordance with regulation 15.60.
 3. The approval number LAB7716SP must not be stamped on any other type of cylinder.

This exemption takes effect on **21 December 2018** and expires when the cylinder, namely the Faber cylinder with serial number 03/0709/009, has been stamped with the approval number LAB7716SP and station mark of Ocean's Alive New Zealand Limited.
