

# Notice of Amendment to Exemption

---

In accordance with section 220 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 (the Act), exemption HS2207 granted to Civil Aviation Authority of New Zealand on 27 August 2024 in relation to the Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017 and the storage of explosive substances is amended to provide for a new position for the storage location identified as Location D in the Notice of Exemption.

The new position for Location D is specified in the accompanying letter from Sharon Thompson, Chief Executive at WorkSafe New Zealand, to Monique Masoe, National Manager Explosive Detector Dog Unit at New Zealand Aviation Security Service.

This amendment does not amend or change any other matter of exemption HS2207. The conditions applying to Location D for exemption HS2207, as specified in the Notice of Exemption dated 27 August 2024, are unchanged and remain in force.

This amendment takes effect from the date specified in the *Gazette* notice required by section 221 the Act, which will be 9 January 2025 and expires on 30 August 2029 unless it is replaced sooner or revoked. This amendment is given the reference HS2207A.
